

## CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

### **REGIONAL GEOLOGY (G – 20.02) "Permo-Carboniferous to Early Jurassic, Karoo Supergroup of eastern Gondwana" during the 32<sup>nd</sup> IGC supported by COGEOENVIRONMENT & Geological Society Africa**

The second circular of 32<sup>nd</sup> International Geological Congress (IGC) in Florence, August 2004 has just appeared in which you might have found details for the abstract submission (can be seen also in the IGC website, <http://www.32igc.org/> at anytime). At this occasion, we would like to invite you to contribute to the **REGIONAL GEOLOGY symposium (G – 20.02) "Permo-Carboniferous to Early Jurassic, Karoo Supergroup of eastern Gondwana"** of 32<sup>nd</sup> IGC.

The main focus of the symposium is the evolution of eastern Gondwana during the deposition and sedimentation of the Karoo Supergroup from Late Carboniferous to Early Jurassic. Presentations are invited which include topics on tectonics, sedimentologic, paleogeographic, paleoclimatic, paleontologic, palynology, economic potential (coal, hydrocarbons and other resources), etc. Techniques in the study of the Karoo sediments such as use of seismic, remote sensing etc. are also encouraged. At the end of the symposium, an open forum summarizing the main topics will be convened to highlight the present state of understanding of the Karoo.

Abstracts are invited to be given orally or as poster by the senior author or designated presenter. The period of abstract submission is from May 1<sup>st</sup> 2003 to JANUARY 10<sup>th</sup> 2004, i.e., THE DEAD LINE IS JANUARY 10<sup>th</sup> 2004.
